

MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD 14 IHR 08

SUBJECT: Adult steelhead mortality found on August 24, 2014, at the juvenile fish collection channel.

- A. Species – *Oncorhynchus mykiss*.
- B. Origin – unknown.
- C. Length – 28”
- D. Marks and tags – clipped
- E. Marks and injuries found on carcass – none.
- F. Location – The fish was found on the walkway grating of the juvenile fish collection channel, above and adjacent to orifice 6C south.
- G. Cause and time of death – The fish had jumped out of the channel sometime over the weekend. The existing jump-netting extends to approximately 12’ above the water surface. The grating has a small gap that would be very difficult, if not impossible, for an adult fish to fit through.
- H. Future and preventative measures – Will continue to assess and monitor the juvenile channel to determine specific areas that may be prone to fish jumping out and install additional netting or other barriers as necessary.
