MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD 22 IHR 06 MFR Date Change Condition Monitoring

SUBJECT: Condition monitoring was moved from July 4 to July 5, 2022.

Condition monitoring at Ice Harbor Dam occurs no less than twice per week with no more than three days between sample days (FPP; Chapter 6; 2.3.2.5.), typically on Mondays and Thursdays. Due to a family medical emergency, critical short-staffing and unavailability of coverage on Monday July 4, Ice Harbor staff conducted condition monitoring on July 5. This action was coordinated with NOAA fisheries prior to being conducted. Results from condition monitoring are listed in Table 1 and Table 2.
