MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD 20 LGS 04 Unit 6 Testing

SUBJECT: Little Goose Unit 6 Operational Testing

Background

Little Goose Unit 6 tripped offline due to the XJ breaker opening on April 04 at 05:21. The Unit was placed back in service on April 05 and April 13 and tripped offline on both occasions. Little Goose staff have made various attempts to troubleshoot components associated with the Unit 6 XJ breaker to determine the cause.

Unit priority for Little Goose was Units 1, 6, 2, 3, 4, 5 from April 03 through June 20, as outlined in the Fish Passage Plan (FPP, Chapter 8, Table LGS-5). However, a Memorandum of Coordination (MOC) was recently approved which outlined minimum generation for Unit 1 as well as changed Unit priority to Units 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6. The MOC (20 LGS 03) was approved and placed into effect on April 16, 2020. The Columbia River Teletype (CBT) was sent to Little Goose at approximately 17:10.

Little Goose operated Unit 6 outside of Unit priority, outlined above, at speed no load on multiple occasions to troubleshoot tripping malfunction associated with the XJ breaker. While operational testing is allowed for up to 30 minutes (FPP, Chapter 8, 4.3.6. Operational Testing), Unit 6 was operated on multiple occasions for periods exceeding 30 minutes (Table 1).
