MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD: 17 LWG 10 Emergency Debris Spill

Subject: Emergency Spill Operation

Debris in the Lower Granite forebay continues to accumulate in front of the spillway and powerhouse. On June 8 from 0711-0826, an emergency debris spill operation was undertaken. Spill operations deviated from the Fish Passage Plan (FPP) spill pattern during this emergency spill operation by closing the RSW and having spillway 3 full open. Spill volume was unchanged during the emergency debris spill.
