MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD: 22 LWG 12 Jack Chinook Salmon Mortalities

SUBJECT: Jack Chinook Salmon mortality

An unclipped Jack Chinook salmon mortality was found on the pavement downstream of the picketed leads during the October 7 fish ladder inspection. There were no marks on the fish and the location the fish came from was undermined.

- A. Species – Jack Chinook salmon.
- B. Origin – Unclipped.
- C. Length – About 17.3 inches.
- D. Marks and tags – No tags.
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – Carcasses did not have any obvious injuries.
- F. Cause and Time of Death – The fish likely jumped from an unknown section or the ladder.
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – The location the fish was found makes it difficult to identify what section that may be an issue to address with preventative measures.
