1. Action Items.

- 1.1. Project Fisheries will include the maximum number counted per day in a table included in the weekly report.

- 3. Fredricks provided a memo for discussion. He is asking for standardized reporting from the Projects. He thought the Project reporting was fine but from a Regional Manager perspective, it would be easier to compare avian activity up throughout the basin if a few changes were made to the reporting tables. He is not asking anyone to change anything already in the reports, he would just like to see this table added.
- **4.** Zorich and Fredricks discussed the information to include. Zorich suggested noting what the birds are doing would be useful but Fredricks said he is not asking the Projects to increase or add to their monitoring. The LMN table was the recommended example.
