

CTUIR Lamprey Trapping Season Report for US Army Corp FPOM members, 10/28/11

- The table provides location, numbers (daily and season) and dates collected for CTUIR trapping only.
- CTUIR brood collection began on 30 May 11 with a few fish collected by NOAA/PSMFC staff at Bonneville and provided to the tribes.
- Trapping began on 21 June 11 at the North and South ladders at John Day with funnel traps placed behind picketed leads; and at the East and North ladders with funnel traps placed behind picketed leads.
- Upon FPOM approval , one trap was placed inside the East Rocky channel section at The Dalles on 18 July 11. Fishing at this location was very difficult due to high velocity and the trap drop-line stability. No lampreys were collected from the Rocky channel in 2011. Unless other methods are developed, CTUIR does not anticipate collection with funnel traps at this location in upcoming years.
- All lampreys collected were transferred to the South Fork Walla Walla Lamprey Holding facility near Milton-Freewater, Oregon. Lampreys were treated with 0.1cc/500 g live weight Oxytetracycline for systemic infections (prophylactic).
- CTUIR pulled all traps on 11 August 11 for the season.
- For 2012, CTUIR will continue to trap in similar manner as the 2011 season.
- CTUIR, Yakama Nation, and Nez Perce desire to increase trapping efficiencies at the picketed lead areas at the lower four dams. As step one, we have toured the facilities with project biologists and research coordinators to discuss our approach, which is to develop flume-like collection channels within the picketed lead areas that would direct lampreys into a central trap box. This trap box could be placed within the picketed lead area and attached to the walls of the fishway to allow easy retrieval on a rail and winch system. Right now, this work is still very preliminary in development and discussion. We will present to FPOM, in the future.
