MEMORANDUM FOR Biologist, Operations Division (CENWP-OD) SUBJECT: Bonneville Project, Fishway and Fish Activities for <u>Week 16</u> of 2019, which covers the period from <u>14-20 April</u>.

### 1. OPERATION SUMMARY:

- a. Daily average river flows ranged from 219.2 to 256.5 kcfs. Daily average powerhouse forebay elevation ranged from 73.4' to 75.1' msl. Daily average project tailwater ranged from 19.2' to 21.8' msl. Secchi disk measurements ranged from 1.0' to 3.0'. Daily average water temperature ranged from 48°F 51°F.
- b. Daily average spill ranged from 113.0 to 118.4 kcfs.
- **c.** Unit Operation. <u>PH2 remains the priority powerhouse.</u> Main unit drawdowns are measured every Monday and more frequently as needed.

- d. Fish Units. Second Powerhouse fish units provide attraction flow for the Washington Shore (WS) fish ladder.
  - <u>Fish Unit Outages.</u> Fish Units are periodically placed into reserve service (RS) to float trash when debris differentials become excessive and trash raking is not possible.

#### 2. MAINTENANCE ACTIVITIES:

- a. Auxiliary Water System Closures.
  - FV1-1 was closed from 0823 to 0905 on 15 April and from 0736 to 0810 on 18 April for trash rack cleaning.
- b. <u>STS/VBS Inspections</u>. Nothing to report.
- c. <u>Dewatering and Fish Salvages.</u> Nothing to report.

### **RESEARCH:**

- a. <u>Fisheries Field Unit Fish counting</u>: Daytime visual counting (0500 to 2100) began on 01 April. Fish counts can be viewed **here**.
- b. <u>PSMFC Smolt Monitoring</u>: Sample collections at the SMF began at 0700 on 02 March. Debris at the PDS and fish/debris separator ranged from light to moderate consisting mostly of sticks and other woody debris. Gas Bubble Trauma (GBT) examinations began on 13 April and are typically performed two days per week through the end of spill. Results of this week's Gas Bubble Trauma (GBT) examinations: 200 yearling Chinook and Steelhead examined: two fish (1.0%) were observed with GBT symptoms. Please follow this <u>link</u> to the FPC web page for further details. Fallbacks observed this week: two Steelhead. No fish collections for research were conducted this week.
- c. <u>Fisheries Field Unit Pinniped Monitoring Program</u>: Observations for pinniped abundance and predation began on 02 Jan. The FFU observes five days each week.
- d. USDA Pinniped hazing: Deck-based hazing began 01 March.
- e. CRITFC Pinniped hazing: Hazing by boat began 01 March.

### 3. FISHWAYS:

- a. Project biologists inspected from 14-20 April.

- On 01 May 2018, FG6-11 (Cascades Island) was found broken partially open. The diffuser shaft had broken away from the motor. Due to the subsidence issues at Cascades Island, repairs cannot occur until crane support is allowed in the vicinity.
- On 18 August 2018, FG6-12 (Cascades Island) was found to be mechanically bound in the open position. FG6-12 should only be open with tailwaters ranging from 11.0'-33.0'. Due to the subsidence issues at Cascades Island, repairs cannot occur until crane support is allowed in the vicinity.
- On 27 March 2019, FG6-18 (Cascades Island) was found to be mechanically bound in the closed position. FG6-18 should be open with tailwaters > 12.0'. Due to the subsidence issues at Cascades Island, repairs cannot occur until crane support is allowed in the vicinity.

## c. Adult Fishways.

- (1) The AFF remains in service.
- (2) Sensor calibration occurred on 18 April.
- (3) SLEDs are installed at all locations.

## d. Juvenile Fishways.

- (1) The ITS was opened (auto-chain gates 3B, 6C, & 10B only no fixed gates 1A or 1B) per the 15 March teletype. The ITS will be open 24/7 until repairs can be made to the lower gate.
- (2) The hydro-cannon remains in service.
- (3) The B2CC remains in service.
- (4) The DSM remains in service.
- (5) STSs are installed.

# e. Lamprey Fishways.

- (1) WA Shore LPS was returned to service on 11 April.
- (2) Cascades Island LPS was returned to service on 16 April.
- (3) Bradford Island LPS was returned to service on 18 April.


