MEMORANDUM FOR Biologist, Operations Division (CENWP-OD)

SUBJECT: Bonneville Project, Fishway and Fish Activities for <u>Week 12</u> of 2021, which covers the period from <u>14</u> to 20 March 2021.

1. OPERATION SUMMARY:

- **a.** Daily a verage river flows ranged from 127.6 to 132.1 kcfs. Daily a verage powerhouse forebay elevation ranged from 73.6' to 74.6' msl. Daily a verage project tailwater ranged from 12.0' to 12.1' msl. Secchi disk measurements ranged from 6.0' to 7.0'. Daily average water temperature ranged from 42 to 43°F.
- b. Daily average spill ranged from 1.3 to 1.5 kcfs.
- **C.** Unit Operation. <u>PH2 remains the priority powerhouse</u>. Main unit drawdowns are measured every Monday and more frequently as needed.

d. Fish Units. Second Powerhouse fish units provide attraction flow for the Washington Shore (WS) fish ladder.

<u>Fish Unit Outages.</u> Fish Units are periodically placed into reserve service (RS) to float trash when debris differentials become excessive and trash raking is not possible.

2. MAINTENANCE ACTIVITIES:

- a. Auxiliary Water System Closures.
 - FV 1-1 was closed for cleaning from 1320 to 1415 on 18 March.
 - B2CC was open from 0638 to 1510 on 18 March for trash raking operations.
- b. <u>STS/VBS Inspections</u>. Nothing to report.

- C. <u>Dewatering and Fish Salvages</u>.
 - On 16 March, fish biologists entered the Unit 16 scroll case and draft tube. No fish were observed in the scroll case, but 5 sculpin and 6 juvenile non-salmonid species were recovered in good condition from the draft tube. All fish were released in the forebay.
- d. Nav Lock 2: Nav Lock 2 went out of service for a nnual maintenance at 0600 on 06 March and was marked ready to restore service at 1620 on 17 March.

3. RESEARCH:

- a. <u>Four Peaks Environmental Fish counting contract</u>: Daytime video counting (0400 to 2000) began on 01 December. Fish counts can be viewed <u>here</u>.
- b. <u>USFWS Lamprey Metamorphosis Study:</u> Juvenile lamprey researchers are onsite, and the work is underway.
- C. Pacific States Marine Fisheries Commission Smolt Monitoring: Sample collections at the SMF began at 0700 on 02 March. Debris at the primary dewatering structure (PDS) and fish/debris separated was light consisting mostly of sticks. Kelt observations will be monitored by direct observation from the Smolt Monitoring personnel and video recording by Fisheries Field Unit and SMP at least until the Kelt Trigger (20 total including two on two consecutive days) is reached. Fallbacks observed this week included 6 steelhead; bringing the year-to-date total to 13. No fish collections for research purposes were conducted this week. - d. Northbank: FGE (Fish Guidance Efficiency) work continued on U15.
- e. <u>USDA Pinniped hazing</u>: Deck-based hazing began 08 March

C. Adult Fishways.

- (1) The AFF was taken out of service for the winter on 25 Nov.

- (3) SLEDs are installed at all locations.

d. Juvenile Fishways.

- (1) The ITS remains in service (auto-chain gates 3B, 6C, & 10B only).

- (4) The DSM remains in service.
- (5) STS's remain in service.

e. <u>Lamprey Fishways</u>.


- (1) LPSs remain out of service.

8. TELETYPES CURRENTLY IN EFFECT:

- A teletype was sent out 30 December stating effective 1 January 2021 at 0001 hours, until further notice, the Bonneville Dam minimum tailwater elevation is 11.8 feet during all hours. The intent of this teletype is to provide sufficient tailwater elevation to protect the chum redds in the Ives/Pierce Island are during the egg incubation period. This teletype replaces the previous CBT message: BON R 122019 0926. Please see teletype BON R 122920 1520 for more details.
- A teletype was sent out 02 March stating the Bonneville Dam forebay is to remain above 74.5 feet from 09-11 March, with a soft constraint. This operation is to support a hydrosurvey in shallow waters near the Hood River Bridge. Please see CBT message BON R 030221 0804 for more details.

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
