**COORDINATION TITLE** - 17CGR05 MFR Cougar Fish Facility Oil Release

**NOTIFICATION DATE** - 26 October 2017

**PROJECT** - Cougar Dam (Fish Facility)

**RESPONSE DATE** - 17 November 2017

**Description of the problem** - At 1030 on October 26, 2017 a sheen was identified in the presort pool at the Cougar Fish Facility thought to be coming from a pump. The pump was removed and booms were installed. The estimated amount was less than a cup.

**Impact on facility operation** - There was minimal impact to the Cougar Fish Facility and is already shutdown for the season.

**Dates of impacts/repairs** - October 26

**Expected impacts on fish** - There were minimal impacts to fish from the oil release. The amount of oil released was estimated at less than a cup and there were no fish observed at the facility. The facility was shut down for the season the same week of this incident.

**Comments from agencies** – No comments

**Final results** - The Willamette Fish Operations Plan (WFOP) requires notification to the Services as a result of unplanned events that impact fish and was completed by e-mail and this memorandum for the record.
