9:35 Prep for the Manager's FY19 Middle Fork RM&E Plan Check-In

At their March 5th meeting the Steering Team identified next steps in preparing for the Manager FY19 Middle Fork RM&E check-in, which is scheduled to take place at the April 30th Managers Forum meeting. In preparation the Steering Team requested that the RM&E Team consider the information available (or still needed) to support upcoming management decisions. Specific information needs include, but are not limited to the following (as described in the Middle Fork RM&E Plan Executive Summary, pg. 2-3):

- a. FY19 biological check-in, which is intended to be the earliest point at which to determine the feasibility of downstream fish passage at LOP and to report on results of studies, reducing uncertainties around each alternative, and if appropriate, narrowing alternatives for further study or if additional alternatives should be considered.
- b. At each Check-In Meeting, managers will consider:
 - 1. Should any alternative be removed from consideration?
 - 2. Should any alternative be added for consideration?
 - 3. What additional information is needed to support fish passage decisions in the MFW?
- c. Information summarized on spring Chinook Salmon for discussion at the FY19 and FY21 check-in meetings will include, for each alternative (as applicable and where information is available):
 - 1. Adult and juvenile fish collection and passage efficiency
 - 2. Adult and juvenile fish survival and injury rates
 - 3. Adult and juvenile migration timing
 - 4. Recruits per spawner
