- When we are not working or treating adult fish we have been pressure washing ponds, monthly reports, etc. to fill out the rest of our week.

- We noticed that it looked like we were running short in our .5/lb trophy pond so we inventoried remaining fish and we are short of about 1000 fish. - A tour was given to 120 Clover Ridge Elementary students.
- All other activities consisted of fish feeding and pond cleaning.
