Ladder modification was identified in the CMP as an action that may increase attraction and thereby help to reduce the proportion of hatchery-origin fall Chinook on the natural spawning grounds.

There is concern about treating them with Florifenicol again because of the issues we had with toxicity, so we have started them on feed mixed with TM- 200 and will see how it goes.
- We started marking this week, and with the Rb being sick we are trying to get the steelhead done while the Rb are being treated. We have a crew of experienced markers and everything is going well.
- Luke and Tyler attended the production meeting in Roseburg on Wed.
- We are getting the pond prepped so we can grade and split-out the 3315 StS next week.
