- From Aug. 29th through Sept. 4th we have received 1.7" of rainfall. The rain was very welcome as we were stretching the available water as far as it could go. We rely on 100% reuse water this time of year for 147,000 of our Rb and StS. We have been able to increase flow to ponds that needed it, and are hopeful that the river level will not drop back to its previous level.
- We are continuing to treat the 2415 and 3315 StS for Ich. The treatments are going well but the fish are still flashing, we haven't seen any loss from the Ich. but the fish are not acting normally. We are optimistic that the treatment will be effective.
- Our lib. truck had one tire replaced by Les Schwab due to being really worn and weather checked. The tire had been on the truck since 1997.
- We put together a bulk order of Smith Root electro. fish handling gloves. All together between RR, Cole Rivers, Trask, and the Mid. Coast STEP program we ordered 11 pairs and received a 15% discount.
- We have been busy painting buildings and preparing spawning equip. as time allows.
- We took a load of non-chlorinated ice to the State Fair to bring down the temp. of the ODFW aquarium due to a fish dying and clogging the chiller inlet. The fish had been removed and the chillers were operating, but the temperature had gone up to 79 degrees during the time the chillers were off. The temp. was down to 66 when we arrived, and the remaining fish looked o k
