

1. Page 27. Section 6.3.1 Albeni Falls Dam Fall and Winter Coordination  
Removal of the description of the “decision support tree” does not necessarily mean it may not be considered.
2. Page 33. Section 6.4.9 Summer Operations  
Second paragraph: The primary requirement for the drawdown is to augment salmon flows. This should be the primary reason, followed by needs for local resident fish needs.
3. Page 39. Section 6.8.5 Project Maintenance  
The heads up about Dworshak turbine maintenance is appreciated, but more specific dates, rather than just “as soon as possible”, and the potential impact scenarios anticipated would be useful.
4. Page 40. Section 6.10.3 Spring Flow Objective:s  
“...the flow in the Snake River primarily depends on the volume and shape of the natural runoff, and available augmentation volumes ~~available are~~ may be small in comparison to the objective.”
5. Page 41. Section 6.10.4 Summer Flow Objectives

6. Page 43. 6.14.3 Summer Flow Objectives

7. Page 44. 6.15 John Day Dam  
Section 6.11.5 “Goose Nesting” found in the previous version has been removed in the current version. Does this mean that the previous operation of inundating the goose nesting areas between March and May is no longer required or desired by the refuge?
